Immunizations Schedule

The following is a list of immunizations to be given to your child. A provider must examine your child prior to any immunizations given. In most cases, even if the child is sick, immunizations can still be given. Here are a few things to expect:

3-5 Days	Physical Only, Audio Screen (AS) EPDS (mom)
2 Weeks	New Born Screen #2, AS, EPDS (mom)
2 Months	DTaP/IPV/HIB/HepB/Prev, Rota, AS
4 Months	DTaP/IPV/HIB/Prev/Rota, AS
6 Months	DTaP/IPV/HIB/HepB/Prev/Rota, Dental, Pb Q, Vision
9 Months	Physical, ASQ, Vision, AS, Pb Q, Vision Dental
12 Months	MMR/Varicella/HIB/HepA, H&H, Pb, TB Q, Dental
15 Months	DTaP/Prev, Pb Q, AS, Dental
18 Months	Hep A, Pb Q, M-CHAT, Dental, ASQ, AS
24 Months	H&H, Pb Q, ASQ, M-CHAT, TB Q, Dental, AS, Vision
2 ½ Years	Dental, AS
3 Years	Physical Only, ASQ, TB Q, Pb Q, Vision, Dental, AS
4 Years	DTaP/IPV/MMR/VARICELLA, ASQ, VISION, AUDIO

Valley Children's Clinic accepts walk-in patients; however, it is best to call ahead and make an appointment. All appointments will be seen as close to their scheduled time and walk-in's will be worked-in with the first available provider. If you are a walk-in and request a specific provider, we will do our best to accommodate you with that provider. However, we do not guarantee any specific provider for walk-in patients.

For the safety of our patients and staff, no more than 4 people (patient/family/guest) allowed in the rooms at one time.

Payment Information

Payment is expected in full at the time services are rendered. If the family unit is separated and the parents no longer live together, it is the responsibility of both parents to pay for the child's care regardless of any documentation.

To keep expenses as low as possible we require all co-pays, deductibles and non-covered charges to be paid each visit. Please bring your child's insurance or Medicaid card and a picture ID each visit. Failure to do so may require the visit to be paid in full at the time services are rendered.

For your convenience, we accept most credit cards. However, we do not accept temporary or third-party

checks. If you chose to use a credit card there will be a \$1 convenience fee assessed.

Insurance Information:

For your convenience we participate with many insurance companies and as a courtesy we will bill your insurance. If the insurance company does not respond within 60 days of treatment the parent will be responsible for the full amount charged regardless of insurance contractual agreements.

Release of Medical Information:

This office complies with all Federal, State, and local mandates. On your first visit you must complete several forms. Upon request someone will explain in further detail your rights to the child's medical record, release of information from the record, and all fees associated with copying and mailing the record. *If we receive a request for your child's records to be sent to another PCP, you are terminating Valley Children's Clinic, PA as the PCP for your child.*

Refills and request for completing forms:

All forms require a minimum of 1 week to complete and a \$25 fee will be assessed, no exceptions.
